How to line your kitchen caddy


Bags of any kind are currently unable to be processed at the FOGO composting facility.

Once a truckload of FOGO is unloaded, it is impossible for facility workers to open individual bags to check for contamination.

Also, many so-called compostable bags or caddy liners on supermarket shelves are not truly compostable.


Use paper towel or newspaper to line your caddy or dry material like leaves or shredded paper to help prevent food scraps from sticking.

Instructions on how to fold a simple newspaper caddy liner are detailed below:




Step 1

Lay out a sheet of newspaper, fold down the top left corner to the bottom edge and trim the excess off so that when the triangle is unfolded it will form a square.




Step 2

Fold one corner to match the centre of the other two corners (from green dot to green dot).



Step 3

Then fold the other corner over the last fold (from blue dot to blue dot).



Step 4

Unfold the two flaps at the top, folding them down either side.
