

Hard Waste Collection

Collection Dates and Collection Areas

Collection of items

What time do I need to put my items out for collection?

Registered items must be placed out by 6am on your collection day or no earlier than the day before.

Where must I place my hard waste collection items?

Items must be placed on the nature strip at the front of your property. Avoid placing them on footpaths where possible or anywhere that they may cause a hazard for pedestrians. Items will not be collected from within a property boundary, inside fences, porches or any location other than the nature strip immediately adjacent to the property.

What if I am unable to move my items out to the nature strip for collection?

If you are unable to get your items to the nature strip due to illness, frailty or disability, special arrangements can be made to have your items collected from within your property. If you require assistance, you must advise Council at the time of registration. This can be done online, in person or by phoning Council on 6393 5300.

What happens if I have registered, but my items are not collected on my specified collection day?

Council will make every effort to ensure your registered hard waste is collected on your specified collection day. If your waste is not collected, contact Council on 6393 5300.
