

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Project 6482 – Meander Valley Road, Exton

Stormwater Upgrades – Reinforced Box Culvert

Q1: What is happening at Meander Valley Road, Exton?

Meander Valley Council is undertaking stormwater upgrade works, replacing the existing culvert with a new reinforced concrete box culvert and associated road reinstatement works. See Figure 1 for location of the works.

Q2: Why are these works being carried out?

The project improves stormwater management and infrastructure reliability.

Q3: Who is delivering the works?

Treloar Civil & Quarries on behalf of Meander Valley Council.

Q4: When will construction start?

Construction will commence on 27 May 2026, with minor traffic disruptions expected initially.

Q6: Will there be a road closure?

Yes, a full-time 24-hour road closure will be in place on a section of Meander Valley Road from Thursday 4 June 2026 to Friday 12 June 2026 (inclusive) to allow excavation across Meander Valley Road for the installation of stormwater infrastructure.

Q7: Where will the road closure be?

The closure will be between Station Lane and 3916 Meander Valley Road. See Figure 1.

Q8: Will there be traffic disruptions?

Yes. Traffic disruptions are expected during the works, including a full road closure during culvert installation.

Q9: Will detours be in place?

Yes, traffic management and detours will be implemented. See Figure 2 below for map showing alternative routes.

Q10: Will property access be maintained?

Yes, via designated detours.

Q11: Will emergency access be maintained?

Yes, at all times, via designated detours.

Q12: Will my waste collection service be affected during road works?

No. Waste collection services will continue as normal during the roadworks. Please present your bins as normal on your scheduled Thursday collection day.

Q13: Will school buses be affected?

Yes, please contact your relevant bus provider for travel arrangements during the works. See contact details below.

Q14: What about mail / parcel delivery?

Residential mail and parcel deliveries can still occur during the road closure period, via the signposted detours identified. Signage will be in place early at points of detour from both approaches.

Q15: Will there be water interruptions?

Shutdowns are expected on Thursday 4 June and Thursday 11 June for ~4 hours at a time. Affected residents will be notified seven (7) days in advance by TasWater.

Q16: Can dates change?

Yes, dates are subject to change depending on construction progress and inclement weather conditions.
